PUBLIC BUYERS GUIDE

Rules, Registration, Processes, After the Auction, F.A.Q.'s

What Can The Public Buy?

Manheim Baltimore-Washington is a wholesale auction, meaning that our primary client is the dealer. According to Maryland State Law, public buyers are able to bid on three types of vehicles:

REPOSSESSED UNITS

GSA UNITS / GOV. SURPLUS

VSE UNITS / US MARSHAL.

Dealers are also allowed to bid on these units.

Registration

Our auctions are held every Tuesday starting promptly at 9:30am. You may pre-register on Monday from 12:00pm to 4:00pm. Once you're registered, you will receive a catalog of units you are allowed to bid on. Only the vehicles in that catalog are available for your purchase. Vehicles can also be found on Manheim.com under Public Auctions.



What's The process?

You must bring a \$1,000 deposit in the form of a blank money order(s) in order to receive a bidder badge. You must wear the bidder badge at all times. You are not permitted to talk to the dealers while at the auction. If you win a bid, return to the registration area to retrieve your invoice which includes the total amount due to the auction. If you do not win a bid, return to the registration area to retrieve your deposit back.

After The Auction

If you have successfully bid on a unit and won, Congratulations! You have until 4:00pm on Tuesday to pay for your unit in full. Vehicles must be paid for via Cashier's Check or Money Order only.

F.A.Q.'s

What's the return policy?

All vehicles are sold as is – All sales are final.

When can I look at the cars?

On Monday from 12:00pm - 4:00pm. Cars cannot be driven or moved out of their location.

Does Manheim give me tags?

Manheim does not assist with tags. You will need to get the vehicle transported or you can obtain tags on your own and come back for the vehicle within 7 days.

Can I bring my children?

No one under the age of 18 is permitted to enter the auction. All attendees must have a valid government issued identification.

Do I have to put down a deposit?

Yes, a \$1,000 deposit in the form of blank money order(s) is required. We cannot accept any cash deposits.

Is there a fee to buy a vehicle?

All vehicles are subject to an auction buy fee, to be determined based on the sale price of the vehicle.
